To be maintained, as described in paragraph 5 below, in:

LAKE CREEK AT RIVER MILE 5.5 (NESW, SECTION 24, T13S, R8E WM) TO THE MOUTHS (SECTION 10, T13S, R9E WM)

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.341.

The date of priority is October 11, 1990.

The following conditions apply to the use of water under this certificate:

1. The right is limited to not more than the amounts, in cubic feet per second, during the time periods listed below:

- 2. The water right holder shall measure and report the in-stream flow at gage #14088000 (approximately 300 feet below Suttle Lake), as may be required by the standards for in-stream water right reporting of the Water Resources Commission.
- 3. For purposes of water distribution, this instream right shall not have priority over human or livestock consumption.
- 4. The instream flow allocated pursuant to this water right is not in addition to other instream flows created by a prior water right or designated minimum perennial stream flow.
- 5. For the purpose of determining whether the above mentioned flows are being met, stream measurements are to be made at gage #14088000. Junior water rights will be regulated in favor of this certificate only when stream flow measurements at the gage demonstrate that the flows required to satisfy this certificate are not being met.
