CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SALT CREEK, NORTH YAMHILL RIVER, AND A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6339, a tributary of YAMHILL RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 17.8 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right has been perfected under Permit 39587. The date of priority is JUNE 30, 1975. This right is limited to 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.22 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.02 CFS FOR STOCK or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, BOTH WITHIN DLC 81, SECTION 6, T 3 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1 - SALT CREEK 2340 FEET NORTH AND 1210 FEET WEST; 2 - SALT CREEK AND NORTH YAMHILL RIVER 175 FEET SOUTH AND 1350 FEET WEST BOTH FROM THE NW CORNER OF LOT 2 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4).

WATER TO BE DIVERTED FOR IRRIGATION FROM SALT CREEK AND RESERVOIR WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM SALT CREEK TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM NORTH YAMHILL RIVER PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF WATER DIVERTED FROM ALL SOURCES FOR IRRIGATION SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.22 CFS.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.


This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 81

TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.	

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
