CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES G. DOHERTY 44872 KAHLER BASIN ROAD SPRAY, OR 97874

confirms the right to use the waters of THE JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of THE COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 6.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 45209. The date of priority is JANUARY 28, 1980. This right is limited to 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 9 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 600 FEET SOUTH AND 60 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.1 ACRES SW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.8 ACRES SECTION 10 TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 25 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
