## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOANN SANDSTEDE, JEAN C. BRADLEY AND DONNA J. CLOUGH 135 WEST BERDINE STREET ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of CLOUGH GULCH, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN AND STOCK WATER.

This right was perfected under Permit 47933. The date of priority is JULY 19, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND(CFS); BEING 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.01 CFS FOR STOCK USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 500 FEET SOUTH AND 1640 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 STOCK
NW 1/4 NW 1/4 STOCK AND DOMESTIC
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
