## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN L. WELBURN 919 OLD MELROSE ROAD ROSEBURG, OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.5 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 30697. The date of priority is AUGUST 6, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 22, T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 595 FEET SOUTH AND 2100 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.5 ACRE AS PROJECTED WITHIN STARK DLC 54 SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install head gates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled; and

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 20, 1983, and together with Certificate 76450, supersedes Certificate 38229, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
