CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SUPERSEDED BY CERT. NO. 88038

TUMALO TOWN DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT COMPANY 19806 2ND STREET BEND, OREGON 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of SEEPAGE FROM TUMALO CREEK, a tributary of THE DESCHUTES RIVER, AND THE DESCHUTES RIVER, a tributary of THE COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 14.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 13245. The date of priority is AUGUST 25, 1938. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.55 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

Diversion #1 - NW¼ SE¼, SECTION 6, T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W.M.; 2230 feet North and 1650 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 6.

Diversion #2 - SE¹/₄NE¹/₄, Section 31, T. 16 S., R. 12 E., W.M.; 1860 feet South and 1105 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 31.

Pump Diversion #1 - NW1/4 NE1/4, SECTION 31, T 16 S, R 12 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from April 1 to May 22, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from May 23rd to August 20th of each year, and ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated after August 20th of each year and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from April 1st to November 1st.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
