## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GUSTAF AND LOIS I. SCHAEFER LITTLE RIVER ROAD GLIDE, OREGON 97443

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE RIVER, a tributary of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.09 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 28771. The date of priority is APRIL 22, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.018 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE% SW%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN WIMBERLY DLC 46, SECTION 19, T 26, R 3 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of the water is limited to the period when the flow of the North Umpqua River is more than 525 cfs at it's mouth.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE% SW% 0.55 ACRE TAX LOT 2301
AS PROJECTED WITHIN WIMBERLY DLC 46
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 32652 , State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered \_\_\_\_\_\_, approving Transfer Application 6279.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
