CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J.A. BRADLEY
MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of a SPRING BRANCH, a tributary of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 166.5 ACRES and DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under Permit E-8. The date of priority is JULY 16, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 24, T 6 N, R 35 E, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	3.3 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	26.5 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	26.6 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	40.0 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	35.1 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	35.0 ACRES

SECTION 13

TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the use, and supersedes Certificate 76454, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
