CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE F. STOVALL
ROUTE 2, BOX 74, KINGS VALLEY ROUTE
MONMOUTH, OREGON 97361

confirms the right to use the waters of MAXFIELD CREEK, a tributary of the LUCKIAMUTE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 43.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 12863. The date of priority is OCTOBER 26, 1937. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.538 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 21, T 10 S, R 6 W, W.M., 80 FEET SOUTH AND 1730 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16;

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 46, SECTION 16, T 10 S, R 6 W, W.M., 300 FEET NORTH AND 1220 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16;

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 46, SECTION 16, T 10 S, R 6 W, W.M., 150 FEET NORTH AND 1340 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	2.4 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	27.7 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4	8.6 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	3.0 ACRES

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 46
SECTION 16

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.3 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 46
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled; and

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion under the subject right.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 8, 1980, and supersedes certificate 12511, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE LOCATION OF THE POINTS OF DIVERSION AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 76444.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
