CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LILLIAN F. HUKILL 11100 STERLING CREEK ROAD JACKSONVILLE, OREGON 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLEGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.7 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 36591. The date of priority is OCTOBER 29, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.075 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK USE AND 0.070 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 29, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 680 FEET SOUTH AND 9 FEET WEST FROM THE N¼ CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4% acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ 1.6 ACRES AND STOCK SW¼ SW¼ 1.1 ACRES SECTION 18

TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate correctly describes that portion of the water right NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 30, 1996, approving Transfer Application 7176, and supercedes Certificate 72944, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
