CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HENRY W. HARRIS 36190 MCFADDEN LANE HALFWAY, OREGON 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of PINE CREEK, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 127.3 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 11, at Page 235. The dates of priority are 1883 for irrigation, and 1891 for supplemental irrigation.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 75.27 MINERS INCHES (1.88 cfs) for irrigation, and 47.05 MINERS INCHES (1.18 cfs) for supplemental irrigation, if available at the original points of diversion: FOOT HILLS DITCH for irrigation, and CURRY DITCH for supplemental irrigation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

NE% NE%, SECTION 22, T 7 S, R 45 E, WM; FOOT HILLS DITCH - 250 FEET SOUTH AND 250 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (one miners inch) per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed ONE acre-foot during July, ONE acre-foot during August, and ONE HALF acre-foot during September for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm an historic change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered, and together with Certificate 76505, supersedes Certificate 10236, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
