## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE<sup>1</sup> ISSUED TO

WAMPLER & WERTH FARMS 2490 SOUTH WILLIAMS RD. POWELL BUTTE, OR 97753

confirms the right to use the waters of FIVE WELLS in the CROOKED RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 524.6 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 112.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8720. The date of priority is DECEMBER 11, 1978 FOR 408.9 ACRES OF PRIMARY IRRIGATION AND 16.3 ACRES OF SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, AND DECEMBER 28, 1978 FOR 115.7 ACRES OF PRIMARY IRRIGATION AND 96.4 ACRES OF SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 7.9695 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the original wells; SW¼ SE¼, NE¼ SW¼, and SW¼ NE¼, SECTION 11, T 15 S, R 14 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 980 FEET NORTH AND 1950 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 11; WELL 2 - 2550 FEET NORTH AND 2550 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 11; WELL 3 - 2060 FEET SOUTH AND 2600 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 11; AND WELL 4 - 1090 FEET NORTH AND 1480 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 11, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

SW¼ NE¼, NE¼ SW¼, AND SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 11, T 15 S, R 14 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 980 FEET NORTH AND 1950 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 11, WELL 5 - 2370 FEET NORTH AND 2550 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 11, WELL 2 - 2550 FEET NORTH AND 2550 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 11, WELL 3 - 2060 FEET SOUTH AND 2600 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 11, WELL 4 - 1090 FEET NORTH AND 1480 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include air lines and pressure gauges or an access ports for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The user shall maintain weirs, meters, or other suitable devices, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.
