CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MOUNTAIN VIEW COUNTRY CLUB P.O. BOX 176 JOHN DAY, OREGON 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP in the JOHN DAY RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 33.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-553. The date of priority is MAY 1, 1957. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.42 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The sump is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 21, T 13 S, R 31 E, W.M.; 1480 FEET SOUTH AND 620 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.2 ACRES SECTION 21

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 6.8 ACRES NW 1/4 NW 1/4 18.0 ACRES SECTION 28

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water appropriated at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of appropriation under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 14, 1981, and supersedes Certificate 27784, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE POINT OF DIVERSION AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 75445.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
