CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARTIN AND CATHERINE MORROW
STAR ROUTE 1, BOX 225
MT. VERNON, OREGON 97865

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of the SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 16.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 8186. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 30, 1927. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 13 S, R 28 E, W.M.; 950 FEET SOUTH AND 1220 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 16.0 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install head gates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled; and


The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 8, 1981, and Supersedes Certificate 9907, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
