CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PETER AND JONETTE JANELLI P.O. BOX 532 CULP CREEK, OREGON 97427

confirms the right to use the waters of ROW RIVER, a tributary of COAST FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 29.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 14106. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 2, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; NORTH 70 DEGREES 26 MINUTES EAST 3837 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.8 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.7 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 24.0 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE, PLACE OF USE, AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 17, 1995, and together with an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 4, 1999, approving Transfer Application No. T-7526, supersedes Certificate 47520, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
