CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE L. BROSI
STAR ROUTE BOX 470
WINSTON, OREGON 97496

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER,
for IRRIGATION OF 27.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 4843. The date of priority is OCTOBER 30, 1920. The
amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and
shall not exceed 0.33 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at
the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.;
1490 FEET NORTH AND 2460 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state
officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or
place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is
available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an
order of the Water Resources Director entered November 2, 1981, and supersedes Certificate 3913,
State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to
the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
