CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS P. AND KATHRYN M. O'LAUGHLIN

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, tributary to the YAMHILL RIVER, for the SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 8.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit No. 13895. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1939.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located in the SE¼ NW¼ of Section 4, T5S, R4W, W.M.

The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water right hereby confirmed is appurtenant, is as follows:


NE¼ NE¼ 0.2 ACRES
NW¼ NE¼ 7.8 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED ON D.L.C. 39
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm the right modified by provisions of an order diminishing the right recorded at Special Order Volume 54, Page _____, and supersedes Certificate 15412, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
