CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TRIPLE L RANCHES, INC. RFD FOSSIL, OR 97830

confirms the right to use the water of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, and LAKE CREEK, a tributary of ALDER CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 20.6 ACRES.

The right was perfected under PERMIT 30159. The date of priority is December 8, 1964. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 0.52 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); being 0.42 CFS from the JOHN DAY RIVER and 0.10 CFS from LAKE CREEK provided that any deficiency in the available supply from Lake Creek may be made up by diversion from John Day River provided that the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 0.52 CFS.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LAKE CREEK:

SE¼ SE¼, Section 4, T 9 S, R 23 E, W.M.; 1210 feet North and 240 feet

West from the SE Corner of Section 4.

JOHN DAY RIVER: SE¼ NE¼, Section 9, T 9 S, R 23 E, W.M.; 1440 feet South and 370 feet

West from the SE Corner of Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-fortieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall further be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
