CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

POWDER VALLEY WATER CONTROL DISTRICT P.O. BOX 189 NORTH POWDER, OR 97867

confirms the right to use the water of ROCK CREEK, KILMERQUE CREEK, and LITTLE MUDDY CREEK, a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 280.0 ACRES.

The right was confirmed by decree of the circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER COUNTY. The decree is of record in Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 6, at page 291. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 7.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- 1 NE¼ SW¼, Section 34, Township 7 South, Range 38 East, W.M.; 2960 feet South and 3040 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 34. (Rock Creek Pipeline)
- 2 NW1/4 NE1/4, Section 7, Township 8 South, Range 38 East, W.M. (Ruby Ingram Ford Ditch)

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the certificate recorded at page 73403,

State Record of Water Right Certificates, and supercedes Certificate 73403.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 57911, State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 29, 1989, approving Transfer Application 6234, Volume 43, page 507.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
