CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EMMA H. CUMMINGS

HEPPNER, OR 97836

confirms the right to use the water of WILLOW CREEK, tributary to the Columbia River, and HINTON CREEK, tributary to Willow Creek, for the purpose of IRRIGATION (from April 1st to December 1st of each year).

The right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for MORROW COUNTY. The decree is of record in Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 1, at page 73. The date of priority is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the described purposes and shall not exceed 0.098 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND.


A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ 5.9 ACRES
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 126, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 21, 2000, and recorded at Special Order Volume 54, pages 594 - 595, canceling a portion of said water right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
