This right was perfected under Permit 9729. The date of priority is JULY 3,1930. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.62 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 10837, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered $\underline{AUG~3~0~2000}$, approving Transfer Application 8493.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
