## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

Wayne L. Mills

portland , State of Oregon , has made proof stations satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon of a right to the use of the waters of a tributary of Sand Hollow, and Reservoir No. 3, construction under Permit R541. a tributary of Malheur River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 3009 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 5, 1916;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.44 cubic feet per second;

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use) is as follows: 30 acres in the SEINE; 35 acres in the NEINE; and 35 acres in the NVINE; of Section Twenty-seveny (27); 10 acres in the SVISE; 15 acres in the SEISE; and 15 acres in the SVISE; of Section Twenty-two (22); 35 acres in the SEISE; and 20 acres in the NEISE; of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Twenty-one (21) South, Range Forty-four (44) East of the Willamette Meridian, in Malheur County, Oregon, being a total of 195 acres.

This certificate is to correct and supersede that certain certificate issued on September 1, 1925 and which is recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 6, Page 5475 and which is also recorded in the Record of Water Right Certificates of Malheur County in Book D, at Page 276.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
