CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of McKAY CREEK, a tributary of the CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 25.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 3517. The date of priority is AUGUST 30, 1917. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LAFOLLETTE AND ALLEN DITCH - SE¼ SW¼, SECTION 22, T 13 S, R 16 E, W.M.: NORTH 78° 20 FEET EAST, 2343 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 22.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 33 TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 2428, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered ______, approving Transfer Application 6656.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
