CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO
LOWER HUDSON BAY IRRIGATION COMPANY

confirms the right to use the waters of SWARTZ SPRING CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 237.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 519. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 26, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.225 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NORTH SIDE DITCH - SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

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
