CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CALVIN N. BLESSINGER

confirms the right to use the waters of SWARTZ SPRING CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for IRRIGATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPLY.

This right was perfected under Permit 5673. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 7, 1922. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.1 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT LOWER HUDSON BAY DITCH DIVERSION), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOWER HUDSON BAY DITCH - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.; 1500 FEET NORTH AND 800 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23; AND

ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION - NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.; 800 FEET SOUTH AND 1300 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 8, 1997, and supersedes Certificate 5150, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
