confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 119.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2620. The date of priority is MARCH 20, 1964. This right is limited to not more than 1.50 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW ¼ SE ¼, SECTION 13, T 4 N, R 27 E, W.M.;

1820 FEET NORTH AND 1230 FEET EAST FROM S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans for the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 64731, State Record of Water Right NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 26, 2001, and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Page 36, approving a petition by Westland Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
