## STATE OF OREGON COUNTY OF UMATILLA CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LEE SAVELY ECHO, OREGON 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of BUTTER CREEK AND TRIBUTARIES, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 33.1 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 2102. The date of priority is JULY 3, 1914. This right is limited to not more than 0.51 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows: NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 8, T 3 N, R 28 E, W.M.; NORTH 81 DEGREES 25 MINUTES WEST, 1388 FEET TO SW CORNER, SECTION 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 2847, State Record of Water Right NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 26, 2001, and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Page 36, approving a petition by Westland Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district, and NOT modified by an order of the Director entered on February 2001, and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Page 99 diminishing 9.5 acres to supplemental irrigation.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
