confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER IN LOST LAKE, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 123.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 31351. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 16, 1966. This right is limited to not more than 1.95 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows: SW¼ NW¼, SECTION 10, T 3 N, R 27 E, W.M.; 2020 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 42861, State Record of Water Right NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 26 2001, and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Page 36, approving a petition by Westland Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
