CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM COX

HERMISTON, OR 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the BUTTER CREEK BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 34.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3996. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 15, 1968. This right is limited to not more than 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW ¼ NE ¼, SECTION 31, T 4 N, R 28 E, W.M.;

740 FEET NORTH AND 940 FEET EAST FROM CENTER CORNER, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW % NE % 34.5 SECTION 31 TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 53659, State Record of Water Right NOT canceled by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 26, 2001, and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Page 36, approving a petition by Westland Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
