CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of FIFTEEN MILE CREEK, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, to maintain instream flows for FISHERIES ENHANCEMENT.

The right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WASCO County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at Page 406. The date of priority is 1907.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, during the period JUNE 1 TO SEPTEMBER 28 of each year.

The authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

OLD CHANNEL/LITTLE CREEK DITCH - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 11, T 2 S, R 12 E, W.M. (APPROXIMATELY RIVER MILE 39).

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 11, T 2 S, R 12 E, W.M. (Approximately River Mile 39) to the mouth of Eightmile Creek in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 32, T 2 N, R 14 E, W.M. (River Mile 2.75 on Fifteen Mile Creek).

This instream right shall replace a portion of the existing instream rights for Fifteen Mile Creek, evidenced by Certificates 59678 and 64744, for the stream reach and period described above.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 8217, and supersedes Certificate 5642, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
