confirms the right to use the waters of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for INSTREAM USE.

This right was perfected under Permits 1216 and 26001. The date of priority is MARCH 25, 1912 PLUS ONE MINUTE for 0.0116 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND and JANUARY 16, 1959 PLUS ONE MINUTE for 0.0233 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.0349 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the stream reach to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

FROM THE LITTLE WALLA WALLA HEADGATE-DIVERSION FROM THE WALLA WALLA RIVER AT APPROXIMATELY RIVERMILE 46 IN THE SW ¼ NE ¼ SECTION 12, T 5 N, R 35 E, TO THE NEXT SENIOR WATER RIGHT DIVERSION.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 1, 1999, in Volume 53, Page 1191, Special Order Records of the Water Resources Department, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application 7 and supersedes Certificates 76329 and 76331, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use in the place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
