CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, to maintain instream flows for FISHERIES ENHANCEMENT.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 120. The date of priority is 1884 AND 1904.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.56 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), being 0.34 CFS FOR 1884 and 0.26 CFS FOR 1904, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the authorized point of diversion from the source, during the period APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1 of each year.

The authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26, T 14 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 1370 FEET NORTH AND 190 FEET WEST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 26.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26, T 14 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 1370 FEET NORTH AND 190 FEET WEST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 26, to the mouth of Squaw Creek.

This instream right shall replace a portion of the existing instream rights for Squaw Creek, evidenced by Certificate 73223, during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year and for the stream reach described above.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 8520, and supersedes Certificate 275, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
