CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 55.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8566. The date of priority is JULY 31, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.69 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right..

The well is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 1, T 14 S R 11 E, W.M.; 1240 FEET NORTH AND 1460 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 9.9 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 30.4 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.4 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 12.7 ACRES
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
