CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ERNEST J. AND JUDITH A. JOHNSON 53001 PRESTON LANE MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS 1J AND 2J in the MIDDLE MUD CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 2.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-864. The date of priority is MAY 20, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL 1J - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.; 200 FEET NORTH AND 635 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28; AND

WELL 2J - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.; 225 FEET NORTH AND 610 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.4 ACRES SECTION 28 TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 26, 1997, and together with Certificate 74533, supersedes Certificate 27326, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
