CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. A. AND VIOLA F. MOORE 2992 SOUTH RIVER ROAD GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 0.67 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 8853. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19. 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOCT PER SECOND [IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION - LOT 8 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 550 FEET NORTH AND 320 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 24], or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIF 36 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 1810 FEET NORTH AND 124 FEET EAST OF THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.67 ACRE SECTION 14 TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

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C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The water user shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 15, 1997, and supersedes A PORTION OF Certificate 50650, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
