CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOUIS MILLER COPCO, CALIFORNIA

confirms the right to use the waters of JENNY CREEK, a tributary of the KLAMATH RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 36.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 7559. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 10, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.46 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW1/4 SE1/4, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW'4 SE'4 17.8 ACRES SE'4 SW'4 12.7 ACRES SECTION 28 NE'4 NW'4 5.8 ACRES SECTION 33

TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the certificate recorded at page 76699, State Record of Water Rights Certificates, and supercedes Certificate 76699.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 8982, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 16, 2001, approving Transfer Application 8504.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
