CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 53.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 2868. The date of priority is MARCH 20, 1916. The right is limited to not more than 0.65 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION (Stewart-Aldrich Ditch located within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 18, Township 13 South, Range 28 East, W.M.; South 68 degrees East 840 feet from the NW Corner of Section 18) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 3, T 13 S, R 27 E, W.M.; 1400 FEET NORTH AND 1670 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	10.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	5.4 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4	2.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	19.6 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	5.5 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	10.0 ACRES

SECTION 3


TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 10, 1983, together with Certificate 52550, Special Order recorded in Volume 37, Page 618 and Volume 38, Page 302, Special Order Records of the Water Resources Director, Supersedes Certificate 2853, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
