CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

B. F. ALLEN  
PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of McKAY CREEK, a tributary of the CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 42.0 ACRES, STOCK AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1896.

The use is limited to 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

HELM DITCH.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  24.0 ACRES

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  18.0 ACRES

SECTION 33

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.


This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the certificate recorded at page 76675, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and supercedes Certificate 76675.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 51561, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application 6656 entered on January 12, 2001, and recorded at Special Order Volume 55, Page 21.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
