CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R. HOLZGANG
RUCH, OREGON 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of BISHOP CREEK, tributary of FORREST CREEK, a tributary of the APPELEGATE RIVER, for the IRRIGATION FOR 38.4 ACRES OF LAND.

This right was perfected under Permit 2982. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼	6.0 ACRES
NE¼ SW¼	9.8 ACRES
SW¼ SW¼	17.1 ACRES
SE¼ SW¼	5.5 ACRES


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 1148, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 21 2001, approving Transfer Application 7776.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
