CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

N. W. MUMFORD
FREEWATER, OREGON 97756

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 16.52 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1880 FOR TRACT 1, AND 1903 FOR TRACT 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-HALF MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE MEASURED AT THE POINT OF DIVERSION CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE PLACE OF USE AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 76785.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
