CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

K & E FARMS
P.O. BOX 28

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 61.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9018. The date of priority is AUGUST 7, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.77 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL WELL: NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.; 1410 NORTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 31, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.; 1352.7 FEET SOUTH AND 1332.4 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 31.1 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 30.7 ACRES
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.


When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The types and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of appropriation and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 6, 1998, and together with Certificate 76942, supersedes Certificate 53855, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
