CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MORROW BROTHERS
1204 CHESTNUT
MADRAS, OREGON 97741

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK RESERVOIR, ENLARGED UNDER PERMIT R-6668, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 24.14 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42031. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1976. This right is limited to 32.0 ACRE-FEET, STORED WATER ONLY, MEASURED AT THE POINT OF DIVERSION FROM THE STREAM or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 12 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 380 FEET NORTH AND 80 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 2.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 20.84 ACRES
SECTION 29

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.30 ACRES
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
