## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JIM NARTZ P.O. BOX 25 ASHWOOD, OREGON 97711

confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 48.1 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 42196. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1977. This right is limited to 1.20 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 9 S, R 16 E, W.M.; 220 FEET NORTH AND 230 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SW 1/4 SE 1/4 OF SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 6.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 ACRE SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.4 ACRE SE 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 17.3 ACRES SW 1/4 SW 1/4 5.6 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 18.2 ACRES 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 4.3 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.1 ACRES SECTION 25 TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
