CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANDREW O. LUN
NORTH POWDER, OR 97867

confirms the right to use the water of NORTH POWDER RIVER, a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 199.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

The right was confirmed by decree of the circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION COUNTY. The decree is of record in Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 3, at page 252. The date of priority is 1884 for irrigation of 37.0 acres and 1870 for irrigation of 162.0 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 4.98 cubic feet per second (cfs) from March 1 to June 30 and 2.49 (cfs) from July 1 to October 1 of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 497.5 acre-feet.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 6 South, Range 39 East, W.M.; Lun Ditch — 2,600 feet North and 440 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 28.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH RANGE 39 EAST, W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52516, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an Order of the Water Resources Director entered June 13, 2001, and recorded at Special Order Volume 55, Page 567, and an Order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application 7559, entered September 30, 1996 and recorded at Special Order Volume 50, page 630. This certificate supersedes Certificate 52516.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
