CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID E., JERRY A., AND ANN DULING 54909 HWY 197 MAUPIN, OR 97037

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #1, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 103.3 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 20.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6746. The date of priority is JANUARY 9, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.63 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T. 4 S., R. 14 E., W.M.; 1440 FEET NORTH AND 2260 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
