confirms the right to use the waters of EIGHT MILE CREEK, a tributary of FIFTEEN MILE CREEK, to maintain instream flows for FISHERIES ENHANCEMENT.

This right was perfected under Permit 4320. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 25, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, during the period JUNE 1 TO SEPTEMBER 28 of each year.

The authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 19, T 1 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 290 FEET NORTH AND 2200 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 19.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion in the SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 19, T 1 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 290 FEET NORTH AND 2200 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 19 (Approximately River Mile 18) to the mouth of Eight Mile Creek in the SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 32, T 2 N, R 14 E, W.M. (River Mile 2.75 on Fifteen Mile Creek).

This instream right shall replace a portion of the existing instream rights for Eight Mile Creek, evidenced by Certificates 64743 and 75565, for the stream reach and period described above.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 8595, and supersedes Certificate 4860, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
