## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of EIGHT MILE CREEK, a tributary of FIFTEEN MILE CREEK, to maintain instream flows for FISHERIES ENHANCEMENT.

This right was perfected under Permit 33396. The date of priority is MARCH 28, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, during the period JUNE 1 TO SEPTEMBER 28 of each year.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 19, NW¼ NE¼, SECTION 30, T 1 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 1920 FEET NORTH AND 3330 FEET EAST; 1270 FEET NORTH AND 1890 FEET EAST; BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER, NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 30

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion in the SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 19, NW¼ NE¼, SECTION 30, T 1 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 1920 FEET NORTH AND 3330 FEET EAST; 1270 FEET NORTH AND 1890 FEET EAST; BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER, NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 30 (Approximately River Mile 18) to the mouth of Eight Mile Creek in the SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 32, T 2 N, R 14 E, W.M. (River Mile 2.75 on Fifteen Mile Creek).

This instream right shall replace a portion of the existing instream rights for Eight Mile Creek, evidenced by Certificates 64743 and 75565, for the stream reach and period described above.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 8595, and supersedes Certificate 38189, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
