CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J.C. YAGER
THE DALLES, OREGON 97058

confirms the right to use the waters of EIGHT MILE CREEK, a tributary of FIFTEEN MILE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 4.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 4320. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 25, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.056 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 1 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 290 FEET NORTH AND 2200 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4860, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 20 2001, approving Transfer Application 8595.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
