CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

E. SHELLEY MORGAN
P.O. BOX 565
PORTLAND, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of POST CREEK, a tributary of PHELPS CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 16.3 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 140. The date of priority is AUGUST 7, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.41 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; BEING ABOUT 30 RODS NORTH OF THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 33.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


TAX LOT 2300 NE¼ SW¼ 6.3 ACRES
TAX LOT 2400 & 2403 SE¼ SW¼ 10.0 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 723, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 20 2001, and recorded at Special Order Volume 55, page 633, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture and abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
