CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EVAN SITTON
2211 WHISTLERS PARK ROAD
ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.5 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 33826. The date of priority is AUGUST 19, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.011 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.006 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 6 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 17, T 26 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 40 FEET NORTH AND 40 FEET EAST FROM THE NE CORNER, LOT 6, WHISTLERS PARK ESTATE.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 6 (SE¼ NW¼) 0.5 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 38535, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 03 2001, approving Transfer Application 8165.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
